

## D-Link 300G+ Ethernet Modem - Setup

### Aim of this article:

This article provides a guide to configuring the D-Link 300G+ to connect.

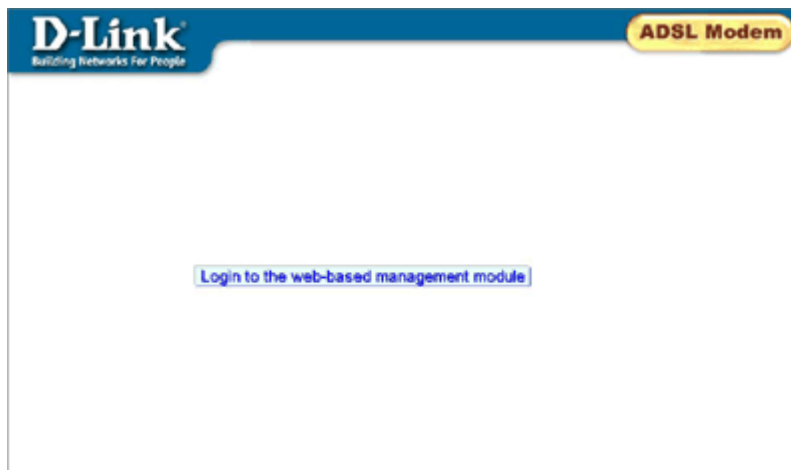
NOTE: The 300G+ is a single-port Ethernet Modem intended for use with a stand-alone PC or Macintosh. If you are sharing a connection with multiple computers you should consider an Ethernet Modem/Router, or a separate Ethernet Router with a WAN interface - such as the Apple Airport Extreme Base Station (see **Related Articles**).

### Configuring the 300G+:

Begin by opening the 300G+'s Web Configuration screen by entering the following address in your Web browser:

**http://192.168.0.1**

You will be presented with a screen similar to the one below:



Click **Login to the web-based management module**.

You will be prompted for a username and password. The defaults are as follows:

*Username:* **admin**

*Password:* **admin**

You will automatically be placed on the **Account Configuration** screen. Your connection settings can be entered in the section which appears below:

The settings on this screen should be as follows:

*Connection Type:* **PPPoA**

*Encapsulation:* **VC Mux**

*User Name:* This should be the username provided in your **Technical Details** e-mail. This is case sensitive.

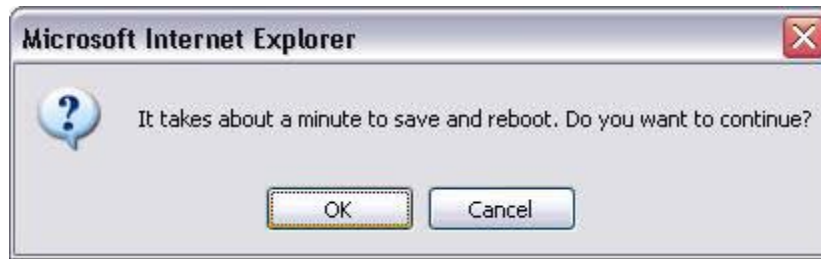
*Password:* This should be the password provided in your **Technical Details** e-mail. This is case sensitive.

*Authentication:* **CHAP**

*Connect On Demand:* **Enabled**

*Idle Timeout:* **0**

Once these settings are entered click **OK**.



Click **OK**. The modem will now save the settings and reboot. Once it is rebooted you will see the Login screen again.

Your Internet connection will be established after about one minute, and you will be able to browse the web.
